Colostrum Management

In this hands-on session, students will work with refractometers, serum samples and colostrum samples and learn how to manage their findings. Trainer Jorge Delgado will discuss and showcase:

- New cow-side test methods that can help estimate colostrum quality and evaluate passive-transfer methods in calves
- When and how much colostrum to feed, and the appropriate methods
- Management strategies, including using colostrum replacers and heat-treating colostrum to reduce bacterial counts in colostrum fed to calves
